The Constitution Party of Virginia, not affiliated with the National Constitution Party, who nominated Don Blankenship, who was responsible for the death of 29 miners, for President, held a Presidential Nominating Convention on Saturday, July 25<sup>th</sup>, 2020 and nominated VIRGINIAN (Fredericksburg) Sheila "SAMM" Tittle for President of the United States and Mathew Hehl of New Jersey for Vice-President of the United States.

The All participants in the Virtual Nominating Convention were required to affirm the following:

- 1. Took an oath to protect, defend the Constitution of the United States and the Constitution of Virginia.
- 2. Believes that the UNBORN Child is protected by the 5<sup>th</sup> Amendment of the Constitution of the United States, that they shall NOT be deprived of their life without due process of law. Protecting INNOCENT Life does NOT require an Amendment to the Constitution.
- 3. That increasing debt is taxing Future Generations of Americans, and therefore TAXATION WITHOUT REPRESENTATION, which is what, started the American Revolution.

As a result of the <u>Decision of Judge John A Gibney Jr.</u>, the Constitution Party of Virginia is required to obtain the signatures of 2,500 Virginia Registered voters on Nominating Petitions, to gain ballot access. During the Trial John Bloom, Chairman of the Constitution Party of Virginia, testified that the CPV was planning to start the "Petition Drive" on April 1<sup>st</sup>, 2020, using the names of "placeholders" for President and Vice-President so they could start obtaining signatures without having Nominees identified. On March 30<sup>th</sup>, Governor Ralph Northam issued his "Stay At Home" order. Mr. Bloom testified that the CPV abandoned plans to start the petition drive to comply with the Governor's "Stay at Home" order, that as an essential Federal Employee, he did not consider the obtaining signatures of registered voters to be an "essential" service. Not only is it not an "essential" service, but does not provide a service to a single resident of Virginia, just the State of Virginia, restricting ballot that the Governor's "Stay At Home" order restricting activities to "essential" services DID NOT apply to obtaining signatures. Since then the Coronavirus Pandemic has been a major Health Crisis and during the Trial, the Judge asked Mr. Bloom, that the CPV did not collect signatures because of the Governor's "Stay At Home" order and the health risk of the Coronavirus Pandemic, is that correct? To which Mr. Bloom responded "ABSOLUTELY!" and the Plaintiffs rested their case.

Mr. Bloom, unlike the State of Virginia, would not risk being responsible for spreading the Coronavirus across Virginia, nor risking the health of Petitioners, signers and the general public, would not ask petitioners to go outside of their home to obtain signatures. The ONLY way to obtain the required signatures, is to utilize social media, email and the internet ask people to download and print the Presidential Nominating Petitions and have members of their family sign the petitions and mail them to him. This has never been done before, but if "We the People of Virginia" are successful at accomplishing this task; this would send a message to all America, that this is the beginning of the end of the Two-Party Duopoly that has corrupted America's Constitutional Government. The Constitution Party of Virginia appeals to the media to inform the people of Virginia, we need their help to gain ballot access in Virginia. Right now even the Libertarian Party of Virginia has not met the 2,500 signature requirement either and there may only be two candidates on the Virginia Ballot for President, Democrat Joe Biden and Republican Donald Trump. The former Soviet Union had ONE Choice for their President; the United States has but two, not what our Founding Fathers envisioned when they established America's Republic in 1787.
